Transportation Options from Chosun Hotel to Incheon International Airport

1) KAL Limousine Bus:

Departs from the front of the hotel and operates at 20-minute intervals from 5:35 a.m. You can purchase tickets for W14,000 at the hotel front desk.

2) Taxi:

Regular taxi fare: approximately W65,000 (these are usually blue and gray in color) Deluxe taxi fare: approximately W85,000 (these are black and gold in color) Tipping is not customary.
